

The 10-Second Rule for “Medicare” Calls

Put these three lines by the phone, and share them with the people you love.

- 1 Medicare doesn’t call you out of the blue to sell or “verify”**
- 2 Never confirm your Medicare number to a caller you didn’t dial**
- 3 Hang up. YOU call: 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227)**

1-800-633-4227

That’s the real Medicare line, the same number printed on the back of your own card.
You dial, so you know who answered.
